

RIDING ON FAITH RODEO QUEEN & PRINCESS CONTEST 2024 RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The contest is open to young ladies ages 14 to 19 for Princess.
2. The contest is open to young ladies ages 20 to 26 for the Queen (for the duration of their reign).
3. You must be a legal resident of the State of Texas for at least 6 months.
4. Must provide birth certificate to confirm age.
5. Must be a legal resident of the State of Texas for at least 6 months.
6. Entry Fee is \$100.00 for Princess Application and \$200.00 for the Queen Contest.
7. each contestant must furnish a horse for horsemanship.
8. All contestants must submit four (4) 8"X10" portrait color photographs (see page 5) o Glamour Photos. Photos must be head and shoulder with plain background and in full Western attire including hat!! A release form from a professional photographer must accompany their work if required.
9. Contestants CANNOT be married, never been married nor had a marriage annulled or have a child. Should this occur during a contestant's reign, she must forfeit the title and return all prizes.
10. Each contestant is responsible for the conduct of HERSELF and her PARENTS and HELPERS. If these people cause any disturbance (abusive speech or comments) the contestant may be disqualified, and judges will be notified.
11. Each contestant must furnish a HORSE for herself for HORSEMANSHIP. A TWELVE (12) MONTH NEGATIVE COGGINS REPORT WILL HAVE TO BE PRESENTED WITH ANY HORSE THAT IS BROUGHT ONTO THE GROUNDS – STAYING OVERNIGHT OR NOT. These Papers WILL BE checked at the gate. Any contestant not providing these papers will be automatically disqualified.
12. Contestants must dress in full Rodeo attire for all aspects of the contest. Jeans, Long Sleeve Shirt, Boots, Cowboy Hat required. Vests or Jackets are not allowed during Horsemanship but allowed in other events.
13. NO CELL PHONES DURING THE PAGEANT.
14. For speeches and interviews please wear the same outfit as noted above.
15. Tardiness will be deducted from the judges' points.
16. Queen & Princess will represent the Riding on Faith Rodeo for 12 months from the date of acceptance

OTHER INFORMATION for ROFR QUEEN & PRINCESS PAGEANT

Judged categories include:

HORSEMANSHIP: Category will include working your horse on the rail and one pattern. A presentation run and interview by judges. NO Spurs, Tie downs (of any kind) or Chaps

SPEECH: A three (3) minute memorized speech will be required. A speech longer than 3 minutes will result in point reduction. The topic is TEXAS FAIR & RODEO (Be original). This will take place at TBD.

PERSONAL INTERVIEWS: The judges will interview each contestant after speech on Saturday.

Personal Presentation: You will model one outfit only. Contestants must dress in full. Rodeo attire for all aspects of the contest. Long Sleeve Shirt, Cowboy Hat, vests, or jackets should be worn for personal presentations.
NO DRESSES ARE ALLOWED for any part of the contest.

APPEARANCE: Accumulative score throughout the contest.

RULES FOR THE 2024

1. Represent the Riding on Faith Rodeo in a positive and lady-like manner.
2. Proper *Queen attire is to be worn at the Rodeo performances when representing Riding on Faith Rodeo
3. Upon crowning, a contracted photographer will be available to take a head shot to be used during the RIDING ON FAITH RODEO and for the year of your reign. You will be responsible for any cost occurred for the prints needed during the event and for future engagements.
4. No Drinking, Smoking or Drugs.
5. KEEP IN CONTACT WITH THE RIDING ON FAITH RODEO AND PAGEANT COORDINATOR FOR SCHEDULED APPEARANCES AND CONTACT INFORMATION. Please keep records of where you appear.
6. Help promote next year's Riding on Faith Rodeo Queen & Princess Pageant.
7. Thank you notes are essential and must be sent to event coordinator after each Appearance.
8. Promptness for appearances. Tardiness will not be tolerated.
9. Winner is to have color photographs taken wearing crown and sash. These photos are to be used for the signing autographs during the Riding on Faith Rodeo Events, or any other public appearances attended.
10. The reigning queen will be 100% liable for both the chaps and the crown while It is in her possession. If for any reason are damaged, you will be liable for the replacement cost of these items.
11. Can not COMPETE in any other pageants during your reign as Miss Riding on Faith Rodeo

Queen Attire:

Hat with crown, belt and buckle, sash, Wrangler jeans, western attire.

No sleeveless blouses.

Contestants will be judged in the following categories:

Horsemanship – which will include working your horse on the rail and one pattern.

Personality –

Western Attire – REMEMBER you do not need to wear leather. You may if you wish, but the most important thing is that your clothing fits well, is appropriate as western wear and that the color is complimentary to you.
